### CHILDREN AND YOUTH

#### EARLY CHILDHOOD (Birth-Pre-K)

**Wednesdays:** Choirs, Moment for Mission, and Bible Books and Games classes are offered on Wednesdays.

#### MIDDLE SCHOOL (Grades 6-8)

**Sundays:** Seeds meets most Sundays at 9:00 a.m. and 10:45 a.m. for 6th-8th graders.  
**Wednesdays:** InnerChange After School Time meets from 4:00 - 6:15 p.m. Chimers Handbell Choir and the Disciples Plus Choir are open to all Middle School youth. Middle School youth and leaders attend the Worship on Wednesday service together at 6:15 p.m. Our main ministry, Crossroads, meets from 7:15 - 8:30 p.m. in The Corner.

#### HIGH SCHOOL (Grades 9-12)

**Sundays:** High School Pathways meets from 10:15-11:45 a.m. on Sunday mornings.  
**Wednesdays:** Chimers Handbell Choir and the Disciples Plus Choir are open to all High School youth. High School Ministry attends the Worship on Wednesday service together at 6:15 p.m. Following worship, High School Ministry meets from 7:15-8:30 p.m. in The Loft.
