Summary of Proposed Updates to Council Rules of Procedure To Be Considered for Final Approval by Council at its June 19, 2018 Meeting

The first proposed update to Council Rules of Procedure would disband the Communications Board of WCC. Communications has become primarily a staff function that requires day to day management able to respond and be proactive as needed. WCC Communications Director Lou Vlahos has been operating this way for some time and the change is working well. As a result, the board has been inactive for the past year.

The following updates to the Rules would accomplish this change:

RofP Section 2.1

Delete "Communications Board" from the list of boards in this section.

RofP Attachment 1, Section 5

Delete the Communications Board Statement of Purpose in this section and renumber Sections 6-11 as Sections 5-10

RofP Attachment 3

Delete "Communications Board" from the organization chart in this attachment

The second update would move forward the due date of Council's final budget from the end of January to the end of February. This change would give the Financial Director (Treasurer) and Council 60 days rather than 30 days to work from presentation of the preliminary budget (due at the end of December) to final budget approval.


