This year we are looking to fill 10 backpacks for students in elementary through high school in our Families Moving Forward Program. As you are all aware, the costs of school supplies have been going up, and many families cannot keep up with the new prices. We're asking you to fill a backpack with supplies for a student as part of Beacon's Back to school drive. We need 5 Backpacks for Elementary students and 5 Backpacks for Middle & High School students.



Items needed for Elementary Backpacks:

Backpack; 24 pack of No. 2 pencils; Pencil Sharpener; Pack of Erasers; Pencil Case; Crayons 24 count; Colored Pencils; Washable Markers; Four-pack Dry Erase Marker; Five Pocket Folders; Five Coordinating Notebooks (Wide- Rule, with colors corresponding to pocket folders); Composition Book; Loose Leaf (Wide-Ruled) Paper; Small Scissors; Glue Sticks; Ruler and Kleenex Box.

Items needed for Middle and High School Backpacks:

Backpack; 24-pack of pencils (Mechanical Preferred); Index Card Packet; Small Calculator; Graphing Calculator (TI 83,84,89) [45 needed total]; Pocket Folder; Five Notebooks (College-Ruled); Divider Pack (for Binders); 3-Ring Binder (2" or 3"); Ink pens pack (black or blue); Loose-Leaf Note paper (College-Ruled); Pack of Highlighters; and Kleenex Boxes.
