**Sign Up:** \$250 deposit by December 18, 2019

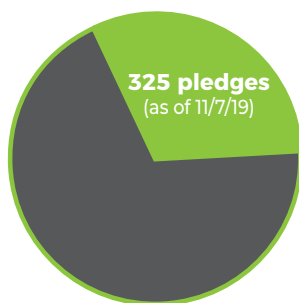
